Principal's Message Tansi! Edlanet'e! Hello!

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Members of the Community,

As we bring the 2024–2025 school year to a close, I want to take a moment to reflect on all that we've accomplished together as a school community. This has been a year filled with growth, challenge, resilience, and deep learning—both academic and cultural—and I am proud of the strength, spirit, and dedication shown by our students, staff, and families.

At Elsie Fabian School, we continue to prioritize an education that reflects the identity and values of our Nation. Our students were engaged in a rich blend of academic learning and cultural knowledge throughout the year. They developed strong foundational skills in literacy and numeracy, explored big ideas through inquiry-based learning, and gained confidence in their own unique strengths and abilities. With the support of dedicated staff, students also deepened their understanding of Cree and Dene language and culture—learning kinship terms, days of the week, traditional phrases, and vocabulary through songs, games, and classroom routines. These lessons not only supported language revitalization but also reinforced our students' sense of identity and belonging.

This year also marked significant progress in our land-based learning program. Students from Kindergarten to Grade 9 took part in seasonal outdoor education activities that included hunting, trapping, skinning, and traditional harvesting practices. These experiences provided not just hands-on skill development, but also meaningful connections to our Elders, the land, and traditional teachings that continue to shape our way of life. Our community's commitment to supporting this work has been deeply appreciated, and we look forward to expanding these opportunities in the years ahead.

Staff collaboration and professional development remained a key focus. Our educators engaged in learning centered on trauma-informed practice, inclusive education, and culturally responsive teaching. We worked together to close academic gaps, review and refine school policies, and ensure our supports align with the needs of our students while honoring the culture and history of our community. In the area of school climate and well-being, our efforts to support the whole child continued. Students learned about emotional regulation, conflict resolution, and kindness through classroom discussions, school-wide initiatives, and presentations such as the RCMP-led WITS program. We are proud of the respectful, caring environment that has been fostered at Elsie Fabian, and will continue to build on these foundations in the coming year.

Looking ahead, our priorities will include strengthening student support services, enhancing Indigenous language instruction, increasing family engagement, and continuing to create space for both academic excellence and traditional knowledge. While many of our operations will remain the same, we've also been working behind the scenes to update and align our school policies to better reflect both our educational goals and our cultural values. More information about these updates will be shared in the fall.

As your principal, it has been an honour to witness the determination of our students, the compassion of our staff, and the unwavering support of our families and community. Thank you for walking alongside us in this work. I wish you all a restful and joyful summer and look forward to welcoming everyone back in the fall.

DIVISION 2 CANOE TRIP TO GREGOIRE LAKE!

THIS MONTH IN LAND-BASED LEARNING, STUDEANTS ENGAGED IN MEANINGFUL AND IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCES FOCUSED ON UNDERSTANDING HOW TO CARE FOR AND SUPPORT THE NATURAL WORLD. THROUGH A VARIETY OF HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES AND OUTDOOR LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES, THEY DEVELOPED A DEEPER APPRECIATION FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND THEIR ROLE IN PROTECTING IT. A HIGHLIGHT OF THE MONTH WAS A FIELD TRIP TO GREGOIRE LAKE, WHERE STUDENTS SPENT THE DAY SURROUNDED BY NATURE, OBSERVING THE LAND, WATER, AND WILDLIFE FIRSTHAND. THIS VISIT PROVIDED A UNIQUE CHANCE TO APPLY THEIR CLASSROOM LEARNING IN A REAL-WORLD SETTING. GRADE 5 AND 6 STUDENTS HAD THE SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY TO GO CANOEING ON THE LAKE, ALLOWING THEM TO EXPERIENCE THE LANDSCAPE FROM A NEW PERSPECTIVE. AS THEY PADDLED THROUGH THE WATER, THEY LEARNED ABOUT THE INTERCONNECTEDNESS OF AQUATIC AND TERRESTRIAL ECOSYSTEMS, THE IMPORTANCE OF CLEAN WATER, AND THE NEED TO PRESERVE NATURAL HABITATS FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS. THE TRIP NOT ONLY ENHANCED THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF LOCAL ECOLOGY BUT ALSO STRENGTHENED THEIR CONNECTION TO THE LAND AND ENCOURAGED A SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR ITS CARE.




























LAND BASE LEARNING AT EFS




